Principal Appointment

A number of our staff will be taking short periods of leave next term for a variety of reasons. Parents of all affected classes will be notified. They will be replaced with teachers who have a relationship with our school to provide continuity in the students learning and welfare.

Morning Drop offs

It has been brought to my attention that we have had a number of children being dropped off in the morning at 8.00am. Our school yard is not supervised until 8.40am and therefore we cannot take responsibility for your child's safety until that time. I would encourage you to make use of our Before School Care program if you are having to drop your child before 8.40am. Should your child be attending either Breakfast Club or Fitness Club they must stay within the club until directed by the supervising adult.

We also cannot have children sitting at the office to be supervised by our office team at this time. All children should be out in the yard until the bell goes at 8.50am, unless it is raining. Thank you for your understanding and support with this matter. Your child's safety is of the utmost importance to us.
