

UNIFORM

PHILOSOPHY

At Mount Waverley North Primary School we believe the wearing of a school uniform gives a student a sense of belonging and pride in the school. It contributes to the positive tone of the school and alleviates the need for parents to be concerned about what their child will wear.

PURPOSE

- To inform parents of what is acceptable in terms of school uniform.
- To provide parents with a convenient and economical option when clothing their child for school.
- To ensure students wear school uniform in order to promote a sense of connectedness and belonging to the school.
- To ensure students wear school uniform so that students are easily identifiable when attending off-campus activities.
- To ensure students promote the standard and tone of the school through correct wearing of the uniform.
- To ensure students wear the correct school uniform in the interests of sun and playground safety.

IMPLEMENTATION

- School Council expects all students will wear the school uniform as specified:

Summer

Navy blue shorts
Navy blue skort
Bottle green polo shirt
White polo shirt
Check summer dress
Black school shoes or runners
Bottle green bomber jacket
Navy blue broad brimmed, bucket or
legionnaires hat

Winter

Navy blue track pants
Navy blue boot leg pants
Navy blue pinafore
Bottle green polo shirt
White polo shirt
Black school shoes or runners
Bottle green bomber jacket

Year 6 students have the option of purchasing a Year 6 jumper

- Leggings, pants and long sleeved tops, of any colour, are not to be worn under summer dresses (unless for religious or cultural reasons).
- Any shorts, skorts, tights or pants that are worn are to be navy blue. Black is not a Mount Waverley North Primary School uniform colour.
- Students are to wear broad brimmed, bucket or legionnaires hat when outside from 1st of September until the 30th of April.
- School shoes, elastic sided boots, sneakers or sturdy sandals (not open toed) are appropriate footwear. Thongs are not permitted.

- Make-up and coloured hair spray are not permitted.
- Watches, sleepers/studs and medical identification bracelets are the only permitted jewellery.
- Hair ornamentation is to be limited to simple items, eg, a headband or ribbons that reflect the school uniform colours.
- Any item of clothing deemed to be inappropriate or offensive is not permitted.
- Parents will be advised of where to purchase new uniforms.
- Mount Waverley North Primary School provides a Second Hand Uniform Shop to support parents with the cost of purchasing uniforms.
- School Council will consider costs when making decisions on additions to the school uniform and uniform suppliers.
- The school community will be consulted on any changes or additions to the school uniform.
- The uniform will be communicated to parents on enrolment, on the school website and regularly in the school newsletter.
- Staff will follow up any student not in school uniform.
- Parents are encouraged to contact the Principal if they have questions or concerns regarding the school uniform.
